

## Open Graph Tags for Zoo (Module, Plugin)

### What the Zip Includes -

The Zip Includes a Module, a plugin and a documentation file/PDF. After downloading the zip extract first, then you will get all these elements. At first read the documentation then proceed for installation. Install the plugin first then the module.

### What the Plugin Does -

The plugin plays the key role to insert all OG tags to the head section of the webpage. It has several control parameters in the plugin back end. Also the default OG configurations tags are listed here.

### What the Module Does -

This is a Joomla Admin Module. This module helps you to insert tags to all Zoo items from the Joomla back end control panel. As this is an Admin Module, You will get it in Administrator section of Module Manager. It has some layout options and category filter parameter. *Remember! This module only works to display all Zoo items with OG tags fields in the admin control panel, so that you can set OG tags to each Zoo Items.*


## Installation and Configuration:

### Step-1:

After downloading the zip, extract first. You will get a plugin, a module and a documentation file (pdf file). Read the documentation to learn detail about installation and configuration.

### Step-2:

Install the Module first, then go to Module Manager. As this is a Joomla Admin module, Select “Administrator” in the search filter, then you will get the module. Open the module.

### Step-3:

Now publish the module in **“Control Panel [cpanel]” Module position**. By default some module options are set. See image below. You can change layout of viewing Zoo items to set OG tags. Also you can display all Zoo Items by selecting **“All categories”** OR you can filter Items by selecting single category.

After Publishing the Module, Go to you Joomla admin control panel (System -> Control Panel) and scroll down to middle. You will see the list of Zoo Items to insert OG tags. If you change the layout from module back end, then the view of this Zoo item list will be changed. **We recommend to use “Modal” Layout or “Slide” layout. Do not insert OG tags now, you have to install the plugin then you can come to the control panel and insert/update OG tags.**

## Step-4:

Up to now, you just published the module and see the list of Zoo items.

Now Install the Plugin (Open Graph tags for Zoo) and Open the plugin from Plugin Manager, Go to Default Configuration Tab and fill required OG information for your site. Remember these default OG tags are for your site Home Page only. You can fill only mandatory fields (\*) Marked if you wish.

**In Plugin Basic Tab, Select Method – “Custom OG Tags” if you wish to set OG tags individually to each Zoo Item. If you select method – “Automatic Data Fetch” Then You don’t have set OG tags to each item, It will automatically set OG tags from Zoo Item Title, description, Image and other details.**

**We recommend - “Custom OG Tags” method.**

**Now enable and save the plugin.**

### **Step-5:**

You have successfully configured the plugin. Now Go to Admin control panel and Insert tags to each Zoo Item. **If your layout is “Modal”, then you will get the tags fields in Modal while clicking on “Insert/Update” Button.**

**If your layout is “Slide”, then Click on Zoo Item Title, It will *collapses in* and show you the fields of OG Tags.**

**If your layout is “Single”, then you have to put Zoo Item ID and then you have to Put OG Tags to that Item.**

**That’s it, after putting OG tags to Zoo Item, Put the Item URL to Facebook Debugger (<https://developers.facebook.com/tools/debug/>) to check if the tags are showing correctly.**
